Ice Fishing contest Rules

- 1. Practice fishing not allowed 24 hours before fishing derby.
- 2. Must have a regular entry (Adult or Junior Ticket) to purchase the extra hole ticket. No sharing.
- 3. Contestants who have purchased an extra hole entry will be allowed on the ice to pick their holes at 11:30 A.M. All other contestants will be allowed on the ice at 12:00 (Noon) by leaving their pail etc. by the hole, but must return to the concession area promptly or be disqualified. You will be notified when you can return to the holes to fish. No chumming is allowed. No fishing allowed before 1:00 P.M. Fish landed after 4:00 P.M. cannot be registered.
- 4. Manitoba fishing regulations in effect and contest rules must be obeyed or contestant will be disqualified. At all times before, during and after the derby, you are responsible for your own safety and actions. Each contestant upon entering the derby will in effect be signing a waiver form.
- 5. All prizes are determined by heaviest weight and time registered. In the event of a tie the first fish registered wins. (eg.) If three five pound fish are registered in the contest the one registered earliest will take a higher place, the fish registered next in time will take following place, etc...
- 6. You may register as many fish as you want. Only one competative prize will be awarded per contestant. Contestants entering more than one fish will have their heaviest fish qualify.
- 7. This is a catch and release derby. All contestants must have a pail (preferably 5 gal.) for transporting fish in water to the weigh-in station. Ticket must be visible on person when bringing

- fish to the weigh station. One entry-one hole, two entries-two holes. Limit of two paid holes per person.
- 8. Anyone fishing without an entry ticket will be removed from the fishing area. No saving holes.
- 9. Only holes drilled by the Lions Clubs will be accepted as fishing holes. Contestants are not allowed to use fish huts, tarps or shelters. Contestants will be allowed to use sleeping bags, blankets, containers, pails, chairs & depth finders.
- 10. No bottles or cans allowed at fishing area.

 Thermoses are permitted, concession stands will be available.
- 11. No motorized vehicles allowed in the contest area other than contest officials and safety vehicles. Shuttle service from parking area will be provided.
- 12. Due to Whitefish Lake being a high management lake, **WALLEYE** will be **EXCLUDED** from the derby as per **DNR** regulations.
- 13. Liquor will be sold at the site. Any person found with liquor not purchased at the site will be disqualified.
- 14. All questions relating to the rules are to be referred to the derby committee. Their decision will be final in all cases. All rules have loopholes. It is the intention of the derby committee to provide an honest and sportsmanlike derby. In the interest of good sportsmanship, entrants are reminded that the "spirit of the rule" will prevail.
